Oxley News

- Welcome to the new owners of the Oxley Pantry and General Store, Jason and Shelley and their children Baden and little Stella. They are doing a great job of running the store and have already made a big effort to get to know our community in their short time here.
- The Oxley Residents' Association held its AGM at the October meeting. Congratulations to our new President Jason Mullins. New members always welcome, meetings are held bi-monthly on the first Tuesday of the month. A reminder that membership fees (\$2 annually) are now due. Membership allows residents voting rights at our meetings which can affect council decision making for our community.
- The **Oxley Memorial Park** redevelopment project was a finalist in the Government Partnership category for the Keep Australia Beautiful Victorian Awards for 2013. Congratulations to the Wangaratta Community Pride Committee and over 90 volunteer community groups who have helped Wangaratta to win Tidy Town of the Year 2013 award for their efforts to protect and enhance their local environment.
- Works at the **Oxley Reserve** continue, with a new fence erected around the pavilion and 3 new tables and seats installed. The Reserve is interested in updating the existing signage and also adding some local history. The Committee has applied for funding to put in a covered area and to upgrade the toilets. Oxley Fire Brigade News

With summer approaching, now is the time to be cleaning up, mowing and moving the load of fire wood away from the house. If you are burning off paddocks or prunings, please adhere to the following recommendations:

- Be aware of your council burn-off Local Laws
- Register the burn with CFA on 1800 668 511
- Check weather conditions
- Tell your neighbours when you plan to burn-off to avoid brigades being called out unnecessarily by a neighbour or passer-by
- Never leave a burn off unattended
- You should never burn-off in hot, dry, windy conditions or if these conditions are forecast during the time that your burn will take place.

Brigade members checked the township's fire plugs on 15 September, with most in good order. We are currently liaising with Rural City of Wangaratta and DEPI to ensure that the fuel reduction slashing programs we have had in place around the township continue this year.
